# Bacon Wrapped Scallops in Bourbon



1/2 cup red onion chopped

2 tbsp honey (can also use maple syrup or golden syrup)

3 ~ 4 tbsp bourbon

1/4 tsp cayenne pepper

Bacon slices

Large scallop whites

## Method:

In a bowl, mix well together the onion, honey, bourbon and cayenne pepper. Add scallop whites and mix gently to coat. Marinate in refrigerator 2 - 4 hours turning occasionally.

Place rashers of bacon away from you on cutting board and roll bacon around scallop. Skewer with water soaked toothpick to hold together. Place on lightly oiled baking pan, foil, or baking paper, rind side up. Spray with cooking oil..Put under grill, for 6- 8 minutes or until bacon is crisp, then turn. Don't overcook the scallops !!!! less is best for them.

Remove burnt toothpicks and skewer with new for serving. If its just the boys over for a beer, dont bother

## Drifting/Drift fishing

While drift fishing with a sea anchor: The key here is keep your GPS on and Hit MARK/MOB when you hook up.



Keep these marks going on 4 -5 drifts and a triangle or pattern shape will appear from the mark locations on the GPS, inside those marks are the location of the schooling fish.

Around 100m is usually far enough for a drift or just keep going until the bites/hook-ups stop.

Alternate the distance of rope out on the Sea Anchor/sometimes the hoop even half out of the water, depending on wind, or tide+wind.

A Shallow spot to deep spot is ideal, stay in touch with line/Bait. Weights will need to change as well so you can get to the school with minimum weight but not have too much angle and therefore line in the water.

Hook ups are a lot of fun, boat goes one way fish, go the other!! sometimes striking the rod is not necessary.

## Catch Micro Jigs




### Uniknot to Uniknot Splice

The best way to connect braided line to monofilament of similar diameter.

1) Pass the braided line and monofilament at least 12 to 18" past each other so that loops can be formed. For a stronger knot, double the braided line.

2-3) Starting with the braided line, make 6 to 8 wraps through the loop and pull to tighten. Do the same with the mono except 4 or 5 wraps are enough. Pull on the tag end. Look to see that the wraps don't cross over each other.

4-5) Pull on the standing lines to jam the knots together. Trim
